PRINCIPALS REPORT Eva Y	<ul> <li>Literacy week was a success. There was a ot of collaboration between classmates, reading club and a lot of parents came in to read with their children in the morning over two days. The book swap was also a success although there was more books for the primary aged children.</li> <li>Basketball for the intermediates is now done. Another success and thanks to the teachers who volunteered to coach and all the parents who helped drive to the games.</li> <li>The school continues to do their emergency drills: lockdown, shelter in place, fire and earthquake.</li> <li>They have created an Earthquake Preparedness committee.         <ul> <li>Have come up with a plan for student dispersal in case of an earthquake.</li> <li>There will be alphabetical groupings (A-G, H-O, P-Z) and children will meet on the field and gather in these groups.</li> <li>Each group will be supervised by staff and receive a lanyard with their identification on it.</li> <li>When parents/guardians etc pick up they will have to show ID to match what is on their emergency contact forms.</li> <li>Each class will have a plastic bin with all of the comfort bags in them (information was sent out about the comfort bags this week).</li> <li>The emergency portable needs to be organized and supplies replenished and will contain a latrine, kitchen and first aid area.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- Term reports will be handed out on March 16<sup>th</sup> the day before spring break.
- Parks and Rec programs continue with multi-sport and chess.
  - Chess has been very popular with 27 students attending and 15 on the wait list
  - They are working on what to offer in the spring (staffing is always an issue for offering these programs)
- Cell phone usage in school has been a big topic lately and the district will talk about it
  - In the meantime, conversations still happen at the school level about using technology responsibly and appropriately
- Gilpin will be reviewed by the district in April which PAC can attend.
  - They will review school plans like literacy and social emotional learning
- The teachers wanted to thank the PAC for their wish list items which were approved in the budget this year
  - In April there will be a visit by an author and a drumming experience for the students
  - In May there will be a drama performance
  - They will be purchasing more gym equipment and outdoor learning supplies as well as story books
- Primary Days of Music will be held on March 11th
- Pink Shirt Day is Feb 28<sup>th</sup> and there will be a COLA at 9:15am which parents are welcome to attend
- The HVAC system will be replaced this summer
- District personnel will be coming in April or May to determine the design of the library and that is scheduled for renovation this coming fall
- Crepe making will happen on April  $12^{\mbox{\tiny th}}$  for grades 1 5
- Question from Lauren- Do we have an AED machine?
  - Not many elementary schools have them and is this something that the PAC should be fundraising for?
  - Ms Young mentioned that there was a recent survey done by the school with what emergency equipment they do have. They will wait to see the results of the survey and then determine next steps if neeed.
- Question from Lauren- What is a COLA and do parents know they can attend?
  - Ms Young mentioned that it means Celebration of Learning Assembly and that she would make it more clear in future emails so that parents know they are welcome.
- Question from Jennifer- The boys bathrooms stall locks don't work well. Can someone look at them?

New Business	<ul> <li>consumables <ul> <li>\$359 was spent on the schools IXL (math) program</li> <li>\$1208.23 was paid for sports jerseys (\$700 of which will be paid through the gaming account as it was an eligible expense- the Grade 7's will pay for the sports jerseys through their fundraising as their legacy gift to the school</li> </ul> </li> <li>The gaming account is at \$13,124.18 <ul> <li>The other change (apart from the jerseys) related to the \$222.84 spent on the photography club supplies</li> </ul> </li> <li>Donations Account is at \$1669.17 <ul> <li>The school spent \$51.53 on office supplies for the PAC</li> </ul> </li> <li>Questions from Jennifer- How did the fundraisers do based on what we put in the budget? <ul> <li>They were not as much as anticipated but sometimes fundraisers are trial and error to determine best timing</li> <li>Could have also been that people were trying to spend less (leaner times)</li> <li>We can look at trends from past fundraisers</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		
FUNDRAISING ALL	<ul> <li>After spring break we should have a fundraising meeting so we can plan ahead for next year</li> <li>We need someone to lead the fundraising initiatives</li> <li>Purdy's &amp; Chef Enrique fundraisers are happening right now</li> </ul>		
PAC ENGAGEMENT ALL	<ul> <li>How can we get more parents to come to PAC meetings and get involved? <ul> <li>Linda and Lisha are done next year so we need people to step into their roles</li> <li>Can we use other methods to let people know there is a PAC meeting as people get a lot of emails and may not see them?</li> <li>Sandwich board announcing when the PAC meeting is etc</li> </ul> </li> <li>Ms Young mentioned that they are planning on having literacy support in the mornings so maybe when that happens we can connect with those parents about PAC etc</li> <li>Parents need to have a clear understanding on what the PAC is and what the roles are</li> </ul>
